The four questions ask whether you would be comfortable to watch the lectures on zoom whilst the club buildings are closed and whether you would be comfortable to come to the club buildings if they open this autumn. We look forward to receiving your answers to the questions and to your views so that we can arrange the lectures in a way that most Members want.
