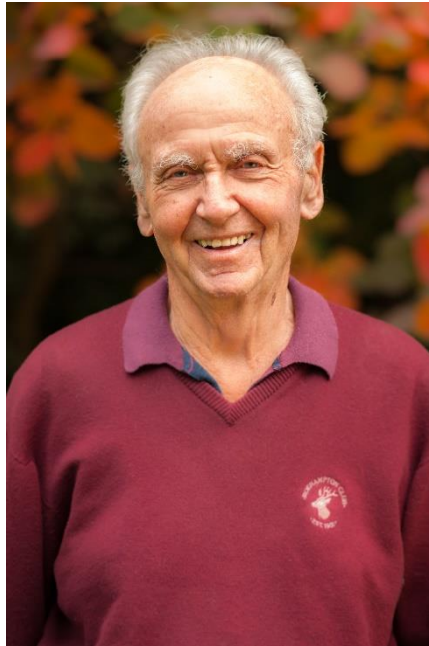


FELIX MERZ

Member of Roehampton Club from 1980 to 2020



It is with immense sadness that we announce the death of a long-standing Member, Felix Merz, who passed away on Friday 11th September 2020 at the age of 92.

His stepdaughter Polly has kindly written the following:

“Felix Merz was born in Brno Czechoslovakia in 1928 and came to England with his brother Joe at the start of WW2. He attended Magdalen College School and Oxford University before a successful career in industry and business. Felix was a gifted tennis player and played regularly at Queens Club and Hurlingham. One of his other great joys was skiing and he enjoyed many seasons on the slopes in Europe especially in the valleys of Chamonix Mont Blanc. Felix died on 11th September after a short period in hospital having enjoyed his last round, with George Trevor and Neil Sinclair, at Roehampton only a week before”.

Felix was a Member of Roehampton Club for over 40 years and was well known to many, particularly those within the golf section. He was a popular member of the Seniors' golf section playing on Wednesday morning. He served as Men's Golf Captain in 1991 and legally advised James Miller, the main shareholder of the Club, when the family sold the Club to the Members in 1989.

He is survived, and much missed, by his wife Frankie, his daughters, stepchildren and eight grandchildren.
