The Wild Beasts of 1905 – Fauve and French Expressionist Painting

Lecture by Frank Woodgate

Live in the Club (no zoom) for Art Group members. No need to book.

Fauvism is the French equivalent of German Expressionism and is full of colour and a sense of joie de vivre; artists such as Matisse and Derain caused a sensation when their works were exhibited alongside a classicized sculpture in Paris in 1905.

A critic referred to the sculpture as *Donatello chez les fauves* (Donatello among the wild beasts), giving the name to the movement.
