It is with immense sadness that we announce the recent death of David Barrie.

David, a Member of the Club for 44 years, was an active member of the golf section and took great pleasure in playing golf with the Seniors. He will be greatly missed by his many friends at the Club. His wife Margaret, who remains a Member, has kindly written the following:

In his youth, David had captained the Stymies, the Cambridge University Second Team at a time when he played to a handicap of 4. He was also a member of The Lucifer Golfing Society and went on their Commonwealth tours.

David was part of a group, including Peter Berryman and his close friend and frequent partner Richard Tarr, who worked hard to achieve their target to gain the Shield contested in the Bowman League by Senior golfers in Surrey. He had had two years National Service in the 11th Hussars, spent mainly in Germany, watching the Russians in their Zone. For that reason, he was overjoyed to win the silver Spitfire in 2006 which is the trophy of the Inter Services golf competition.

The Service of Thanksgiving for David's life will take place on Monday 25th April at 11.30am at St Mary's Church in Barnes.
