This 5-week term will all be about your own landscape, still life inspiration or whatever your choice of theme is. This is a fantastic opportunity to paint your own original pieces which could be exhibited in the November Club art show. I will set a theme each week in terms of subject matter and remind people of past techniques we have covered and various acrylic painting media.

Date	Subject matter
19 th April	Sky predominant painting Demo: 1. How to get a gradated sky with or without a slow drying medium 2. Sky and clouds
26 th April	Water Reflections, boatswhatever reflections you wish. Could even be a mirror reflection Reminder of glazing with landscape, still life, skin.
3 rd May	Still life theme: own photo or still life, THINK about composition, scale of viewpoint, is eye view cropped in or far away? Light dark elements. What interests you in your still life? Is it colour, light, pattern for example? Bring L shapes or use iPhone/iPad for composition and if need be more dramatic values or colour contrasts Will Demo thick painting "impasto" using some extender and discuss the above.
10 th May	A portrait or a figure in your landscape. Reminder of Zorn palette and another 2 colour variation
17 th May	Landscape or your choice. Reminder of trees and different ways to paint them
