

Dress Code for the Golf Course

All golfers must be appropriately and suitably dressed in golfing attire while playing on the course and outdoor practice areas. Members need to ensure that these requirements are made known to their guests.

The Club wishes to foster a smart yet congenial atmosphere for playing golf.

Headgear	Must be appropriate to golf and worn the correct way round.	Must be appropriate to golf and worn the correct way round.
Shirts	Must have a collar or a roll neck and be golf specific. Shirts should be tucked into trousers and shorts. Rugby style shirts and football shirts are prohibited.	Sleeveless shirts must have collars. Collarless shirts must have sleeves. Shirts must be long enough to avoid showing the midriff.
Jumpers/Hoodies	Jumpers should be golf appropriate and hoodies must only have one discreet logo and be golf specific.	Jumpers should be golf appropriate and hoodies must only have one discreet logo and be golf specific.
Trousers	All types of denim jeans, cargo style, combat style, lycra or tracksuit trousers are prohibited.	Trousers and cropped trousers must be tailored for golf. All types of denim jeans or tracksuit trousers are prohibited.
Shorts	Only tailored shorts may be worn subject to finishing above the knee. Cargo style, tennis, or gym shorts are prohibited.	Skirts, shorts, tailored shorts, golf dresses or capris may be worn. Leggings may be worn with a skirt or shorts.
Socks	Must be worn on the course. If socks are visible above the ankle, these must be predominantly white unless they are knee height (golf specific).	Must be worn on the course. If socks are visible above the ankle, these must be predominantly white unless they are knee height (golf specific).
Shoes	Golf specific shoes must be worn at all times on the course. Trainers are not permitted on the golf course.	Golf specific shoes must be worn at all times on the course. Trainers are not permitted on the golf course.

N.B. Golfers entering the Clubhouse should note that Members and guests can wear hats in the Clubhouse, except in the Garden Restaurant and Piano Bar.

Members can wear golf shoes (no metal or plastic spikes) in the Bars as long as they are cleaned before entry.
