
PHOT CLUB LECTURE WITH

JOEL MEYEROWITZ

Joel Meyerowitz is an award-winning photographer whose work has appeared in over 350 exhibitions around the world. He has an exhibition at Tate Modern up to the end of 2024.

Celebrated as a pioneer of colour photography Meyerowitz was the only photographer to gain unrestricted access to Ground Zero after 9/11, which produced a body of work that led him to represent the United States at the Venice Biennale for Architecture in 2002.

Meyerowitz will talk about 'The Gasp Reflex' – how to create photos that represent yourself plus his collaboration with his wife, writer and artist Maggie Barrett in 'The Art of Collaboration'.
