16 <sup>th</sup> Sept.	Landscape of your summer holiday's choice
23 <sup>rd</sup> Sept.	Portrait with side shadow. I can supply an image if you don't have
30 <sup>th</sup> Sept.	Bring in small still life;enlarge. Items could be avocado sliced in half on a napkin (think contrast to object), tomatoes, pepper, sliced. Bite out of an apple. Jam jar full of marmalade, semi peeled tangerine or orange etc, etc.
7 <sup>th</sup> Oct.	Abstracted landscape.
14 <sup>th</sup> Oct.	Composition of white objects on white. Either look at shadows. Look how little true white there is!! There is always Roehampton Club teacup and saucers!! Can work directly from life or photo

28 <sup>th</sup> Oct.	Limiting palette for landscape, purple, white, orange and alizarin Green landscape or scape of choice. Get 2nd copy in black and white. Change up the colours with the above limited palette
4 <sup>th</sup> Nov.	Winter landscape
11 <sup>th</sup> Nov.	Let's do a car of choice within a street scene or on its own. Great for subtle highlights
18 <sup>th</sup> Nov.	Animal?
25 <sup>th</sup> Nov.	Festive Christmas Scene
