The Roehampton Cup is the oldest polo trophy in the United Kingdom. The trophy was first played for at Roehampton Club in 1902. In those days an estimated 10,000 polo ponies were stabled in and around London during the season and Roehampton Club, with Hurlingham and Ranelagh, was the base for one of the three Open Championships of the time.

Today it is played for at the Ham Polo Club, the tournament is played for at a 6-goal level and the finals are held in August.
