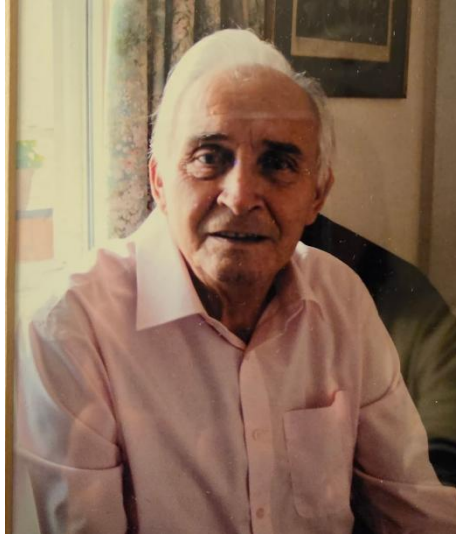


George Rothschild
