Date	Subject matter	Exercise
27/4/26	Simple flower shapes and butterflies	Simple flower shapes. How to use the shape of brush to suggest flower shapes and butterflies. Bring regular watercolour brushes and, if you have these, a small Hake brush, Chinese brushes
4/5/26	<b>NO CLASS</b>	
11/5/26	Spring/Summer trees	Mixing greens and painting trees. Blocking in to suggested textures of leaves, far and near. Watercolours plus a small sponge for textures
18/5/26	An old church/building	Drawing with pen and ink, and watercolour washes and wax resist, sponge, white gouache. Creating a sense of textures and aging
25/5/26	<b>NO CLASS</b>	
1/6/26	The beach	Colour washes, Wet in Wet technique and suggested figures
8/6/26	Outdoor landscape. Possible use of the club's gardens, pond area	Impressionist technique. Subject seen through marks of colour. Watercolour and watercolour pencils or watercolour crayons
