28/4/26	Simple flowers and butterflies	Simple flower shapes. How to use the shape of brush to suggest flower shapes and butterflies. Bring regular watercolour brushes and, if you have Hake brushes, Chinese brushes, please bring
5/5/26	Spring/Summer trees	Mixing greens and painting trees. Blocking in then adding definition of leaves, foliage, far and near. Watercolours and sponge for textures
12/5/26	An old church/building	Mixed media. Pen, ink, watercolours, white gouache, sponge, wax resist. Exploring textures and aging

26/5/26	The beach	Colour washes, Wet in Wet technique and suggested figures
2/5/26	Outdoor landscape. Possible use of the club's gardens, pond area	Impressionist technique. Subject seen through colour. Watercolours and watercolour pencils or watercolour crayons
