They can be paid for at Reception before the lecture using a debit or credit card.

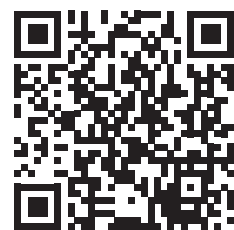
Booking for guests will open on 7th September.
